Overview

A beautiful "Tarrant" house on a private estate in Woking. The brief from the client was to create a sympathetic extension to the original house to provide a three car garage with playroom over. Numerous features were replicated in particular decorative brickwork in the original style.

Internally, a large open-plan kitchen/dining/family space has been created from opening up separate rooms and has created an inviting area for the whole family to enjoy.

The local Residents Association commented: *"You are to be congratulated on the plans for your new garage extension, the Residents' Association committee is very pleased how well it works with the existing house. The extension is something we feel your house will benefit from greatly and adds value to your house and indeed the Estate."*

Decorative brick arches break up the expanse of rear garage wall and will be used to frame planting when landscaping is complete.



Contrasting brickwork is a typical "Tarrant" feature and is sympathetic to other parts of the house as are the choice and colour of the doors.
